- I. **CALL TO ORDER:** Vice-President Pat Roberts called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.
- II. **PRESIDENT'S ANNOUNCEMENTS/MONTHLY REPORTS:**
  - A. **Welcome:** The vice-president welcomed everyone.
  - B. **Minutes:** The motion made by Betty Crick and seconded by Barbara Blatter to accept the corrected minutes of the last meeting was passed.
  - C. **Treasurer's Report:** The last monthly statement was accepted with the motion made by Betty Crick and seconded by Barbara Blatter. Donations of \$250 each will be made to The First Tee of Aiken, The First Tee of Augusta and Hook-a-Kid after the passage of the motion made by Barbara Blatter and seconded by Renee Gibbons.
  - D. **Vice President:** The Master Rotating Schedule and the Tournament and Meeting Calendar 2016-2017 are posted online at csrawga.com. When the Master Rotating Schedule is revised, it is important to note that the following clubs cannot host the Montenyohl Championship luncheon: Cedar Creek, Gordon Lakes, Goshen, Pointe South and Rocky Branch.
- III. **ROLL CALL:** See the above results. Highlighted name indicates the person was present.
- IV. **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**
  - A. **Handicap:** Carrie Dillard is updating the Memorial Cup spreadsheet to reflect the current membership.
  - B. **Rules:** Cathy Reusche shared some word on Advice and Rule 8, giving examples of what is acceptable. More details will be on the CSRA website. Please let her know if there is a rule you would like for her to cover.

- C. **Tournament:** Pace of Play and Spotters Guidelines were received from the Rules chair. A motion was made by Barbara Blatter and seconded by Michele Randrup to add these guidelines to the website. At the next meeting, we will discuss if we want to add these guidelines to the Tournament Rep checklist.

Diane Dorton raised the issue as to whether Woodside Plantation members who play from the Azalea/Burden blended tees are eligible to play in CSRA tournaments. Previously they had been told they could not. Since these tees are rated, the members have valid handicaps and may play in tournaments. They will play from the tournament tees.

There was also a discussion about members of 9-hole leagues joining the CSRAWGA. Article II Section 4 of our bylaws state that eligibility requirements are membership in the ladies' eighteen-hole golf association of a member club.

**V. Unfinished Business:**

- A. A motion was made by Barbara Blatter and seconded by Michele Randrup to adopt the constitution change presented at the last meeting.
- B. The following bylaws change was presented: Article II Section 2: Add: "The yearly dues for a CSRA member are \$10, with such dues waived for lifetime members."

**VI. New Business:**

Charlotte Johnson pointed out that clubs are moving to not allowing outside food to be brought in. If the clubs were to provide breakfast, the cost of tournaments would need to increase. It was felt that there should be uniformity among the clubs. A motion was made by Susie Hodgen and seconded by Pat Wilson to eliminate breakfast at CSRA tournaments. The motion passed. (This does not apply to Team Play events.) The Tournament Invitations will be modified to remove the option for breakfast.

The Secretary requested that the Newsletter be eliminated since it is a duplication of information available elsewhere. The motion made by Barbara Blatter and seconded by Michele Randrup to eliminate the Newsletter was passed.

**VII. ANNOUNCEMENTS:**

Scorers (Carrie Dillard, Pat Wilson and Brooke Hempel) and the Rules official (Carole Rich) have been assigned for the West Lake Stroke Play tournament on November 15 at 9:30 a.m.

The next board meeting will be at The Reserve Club on February 21, 2017 at 9:30 a.m. Invitations for the four-ball tournament at The Reserve Club will be emailed in February.
