**Tournament Guide:** The committee of Charlotte Antaki, Jayne Becker, Carrie Dillard, and Carole Rich met.

Carrie Dillard brought the following questions and recommendations to the Board. **Board answers/votes are in bold.** 1) Do all member of a team in the Lady-Pro need to be from the same club? **YES** 2) Do we want the No Card (no score submitted, but continue to play) available at the Montenyohl? **NO** 3) It states there's an “On course playoff” in the Montenyohl to determine the Champion. Would like to add **“If the course is unplayable, there will be a scorecard playoff.” YES** 4) Recommend creating a section for General Forms containing Rules, Spotters, Slow Play Policy. Spectators. **YES** 5) Recommend creating a form for guidelines for Marshalls. **YES** 6) Recommend combining forms for the Tournament Results. Combine Forms 5 and 6(Back) – same information=The Results. This eliminates the Reps needing to complete two forms with the same information. **YES**

**ACTION TO BE TAKEN:** Charlotte Johnson recommended adding to the 50/50 winners/**closest to the pin** since Gordon Lakes isn't permitted raffles.

7) Recommend combining Forms 3 and 4 (sign up & entry forms) Tournament Entry will be the sign-up sheet and it doesn't need to be in alphabetical order. This does not apply to the Lady Pro because teams are formed by the Rep. **YES** **ACTION TO BE TAKEN:** Remove *alphabetically* in the instructions.

**Fort Gordon Entry:** Jayne Becker didn't receive her Auto Entry after submitting her information. Marion Hansen said correspondence with Fort Gordon was inconsistent.

**Google Calendar:** **ACTION TO BE TAKEN:** Reps need to give their ladies large event dates to the VP Mary Vaarwerk to have it placed on the Google Calendar.
