G. **Tournament:**

Marianne Harris commented that at the Bartram Trail event, there was a tie for First Place in Flight #2. Golf Genius only identifies ties using tiebreakers on the back nine. This tie needed to go to holes 4-9 on the front nine. So, the wrong team was paid first place. A payout of \$24.40 (\$12.20 per person) would be paid from the Treasurer to Carrie Dillard and Aileen Cook. A motion was made by Marianne with a second motion by Charlotte Johnson to accept this payout.

The second topic was hole ranking on scorecards. When a course rating is done, in the absence of hole rankings for females, the hole rankings for the most used tees (usually men's white tees or equivalent) are used. Bartram Trail does not have hole rankings for females.

The cutoff for handicaps is the day of signup or the board meeting, whichever is appropriate.

Golf Genius signup is first come, first served. The number of members eligible to play is dependent on each course. If maximum signup is reached, a member will receive a message from Golf Genius indicating that they are wait listed. Marianne Harris cannot see who receives and reads the Golf Genius invitations. Secretary Mallak again reiterated the importance of ensure that all member's emails are correct. If a change is required, please notify the Secretary.
