PRESIDENT'S ANNOUNCEMENTS/MONTHLY REPORTS:

A. Welcome:

Meeting was started at 9:07 a.m.

President Lou Kressly dedicated the meeting to all mothers. She quoted from Proverb 31:28.

President Kressly also indicated that no Rules Rep has been identified and it is the responsibility of each Club to have a Pro available for any rules questions/issues.

President Kressly also indicated that there would be **NO** May 31 Board Meeting.

B. Minutes:

Secretary Mallak made a motion to approve March Minutes with the amendment to add the date per Vice President Blatter. Jayne Becker made the second motion. Vote was unanimous.

C. Financial Report:

April income was \$296 with zero expenses. The total balance of the Association's financials is \$5,753.

Treasurer Shultz also indicated that the Association received thank you letters from First Tee of Aiken and Augusta for the \$150 donation. In addition, one of the girls from First Tee of Augusta qualified for the Drive, Chip and Putt contest at the past Master's.

Treasurer Shultz (who also in on the First Tee Aiken Board) indicated that the First Tee of Aiken facility is making satisfactory progress. The 9-hole course is finished and being utilized by USC Aiken. A driving range is complete, and a temporary facility is being set up as environmental conditions testing needed to be finalized. Capital funding will be pursued via fund raising for a permanent facility.

D. VICE PRESIDENT:

Vice President Blatter commented on her role on the Board. She mentioned that her responsibilities included three actions:

Bag Tags- Each new member gets a bag tag when joining. If a replacement tag is necessary, the Rep should email the Vice President and the charge for a new tag is \$2.

The second topic was monitoring the Association's Calendar. The group failed to communicate the switch between Cedar Creek and West Lake and concern was expressed over the factual dates on the calendar. An email would be sent out to all Reps to confirm the dates that are posted on the website.

The third topic that Vice President shared was identifying a Slate of Officers this upcoming October. She expressed that the Vice President role is a three-year commitment. First year – Vice President – Second Year – President – Third Year – Past President. It was felt that this individual should be a member of the current Board in order to keep continuity. Vice President Blatter has reached out to one individual but has not received a decision.
