FORMAT:

Divisions: Two --- professional and amateur

Tee boxes: All men play from the designated tees for the day. All ladies, including pros, play from the designated tees for the day.

Format: Two best balls. All pros must play scratch. All other team members use net scores (85% of course handicap).

Scoring: All pros record their gross scores since there is an award for Low Pro. See "Scorecards" below. The team's official scorecard is to be signed by the scorer and attested by one other team member. This scorecard should be turned in before unloading bags. The two best net scores are added together for the Team score on each hole.

Ties: Will be determined by a scorecard playoff following the USGA recommended procedure adopted by the CSRA WGA.

SCORECARDS:

- For the sake of clarity and score-checking, enter everyone's GROSS SCORE ONLY for each hole. Do not try to squeeze in the net score in those little squares.
- 2. Circle the two gross scores that will count.
- 3. On the net score line, enter the net score, which will be the sum of the two circled gross scores, minus strokes.
