Prizes:

There will be a \$50 gift card for the winning low pro. A rotating plaque suitable for club display will be awarded to the first-place team in each division. The pro and amateur divisions will award first and second place prizes to each team member, with suggested distribution in each division at 30% for the first place team and 20% for the second place team. Prize amounts are determined by total entry fees.

Format:

The format is two best net balls of the foursome. (Players receive 85% of their course handicap.)

Tee Boxes:

Tees are designated by CSRA WGA, not the host club.

Suggested tee assignments: CSRA members from forward tees. Women professionals from senior tees. Club pros and amateur men/women over 60 from senior tees. Club pros and amateur men under 60 from white tees. (Minutes from March, 2026)

Dress Code:

Participants are expected to wear proper golf attire. No denim is allowed.

Entry Procedure:

Each club's representative will submit a completed entry form listing all participants to both the host club's representative and the CSRA WGA tournament chairperson.

In addition, the club representative should submit a check to the host club, covering all entry fees.

If the entry deadline is missed, contact the host club's representative. She may accept entries after the deadline, at her discretion.

Cancellation Policy:

A full refund will be given if the cancellation is made at least 7 days prior to the start of the tournament unless the host club's policy states otherwise. A refund of the cart fee only will be made if the host club's representative is notified of the withdrawal no less than 48 hours prior to the start time of the tournament. No fees will be refunded after the tournament begins. This policy applies to all CSRA WGA tournaments.

TERMS OF COMPETITION



Divisions: Two --- Professional and Amateur

Tee boxes: All men play from the designated tees for the day. All ladies, including pros, play from the designated tees for the day.

Format: Two best balls. All pros must play scratch. All other team members use net scores (85% of course handicap).

Scoring: All pros record their gross scores since there is an award for Low Pro. (See sample scoring below.)

The team's official scorecard is to be signed by the scorer and attested by one other team member. This scorecard should be turned in before unloading bags.

Ties: Will be determined by a scorecard playoff following the USGA recommended procedure adopted by the CSRA WGA.

SCORECARDS:

1. For the sake of clarity and score-checking, enter everyone's GROSS SCORE ONLY for each hole. Do not try to squeeze in the net score in those little squares.
2. Circle the two gross scores that will count.
3. On the net score line, enter the net score, which will be the sum of the two circled gross scores, minus strokes.
