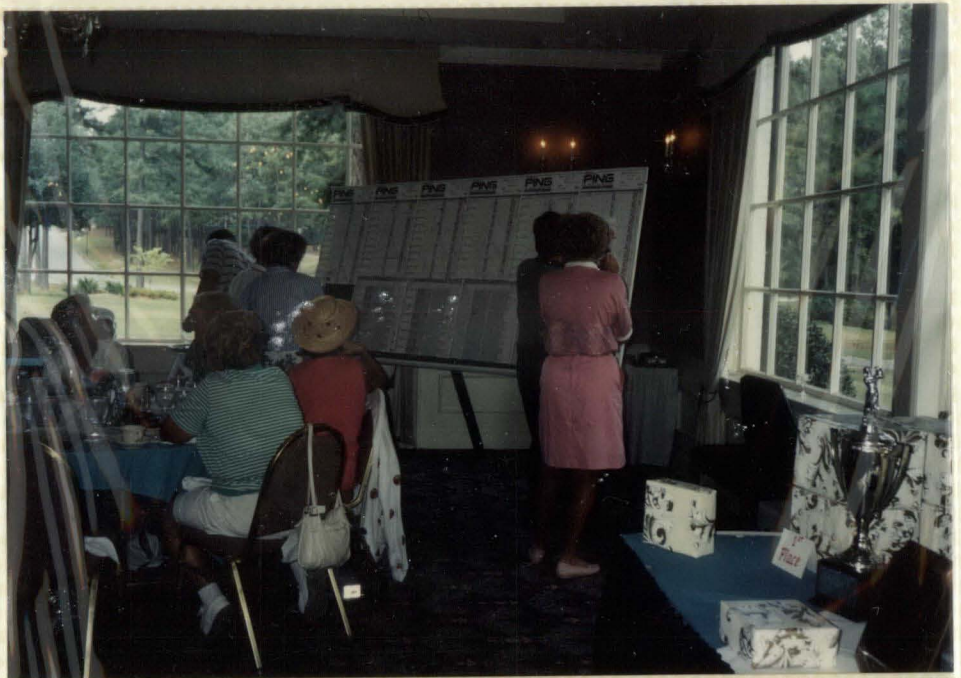

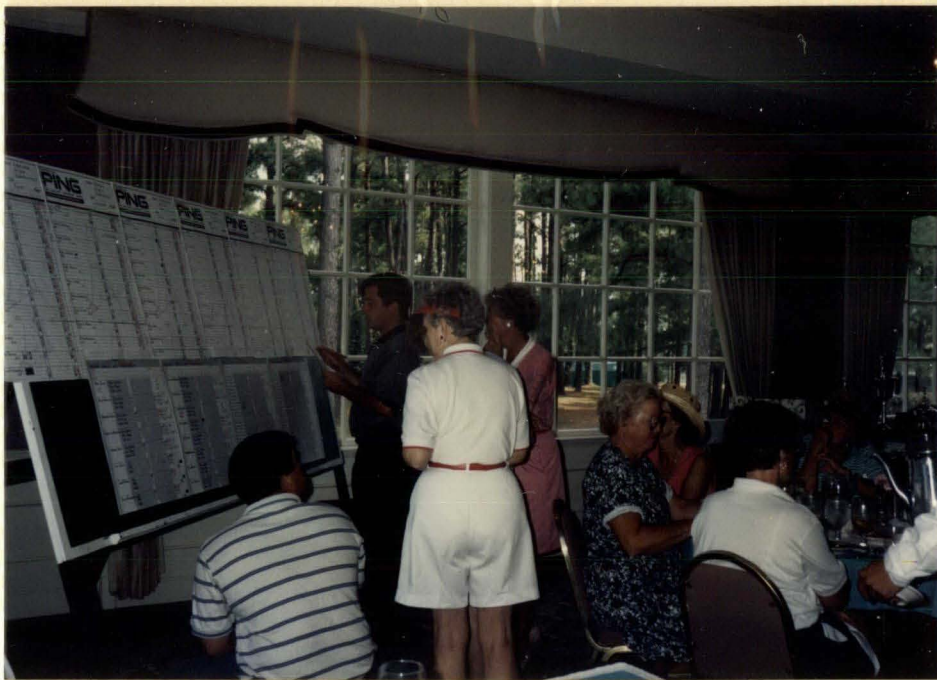

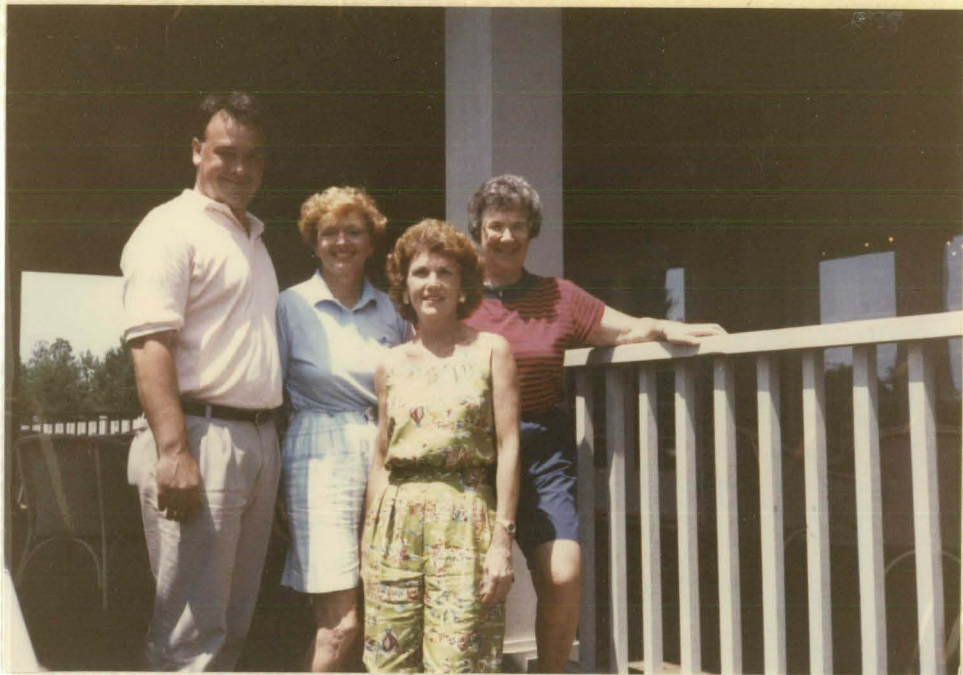

Placing second was Jan Cross of Augusta, who plays out of West Lake Country Club. Cross was the final round's medalist after shooting a 77. Cross finished with a total of 245, two strokes behind Moody.

Winning the low gross in the senior's division was Bea Dodson of Gordon Lakes with a total of 271, while Judy Hanson of West Lake was the senior low net winner with a score of 274.

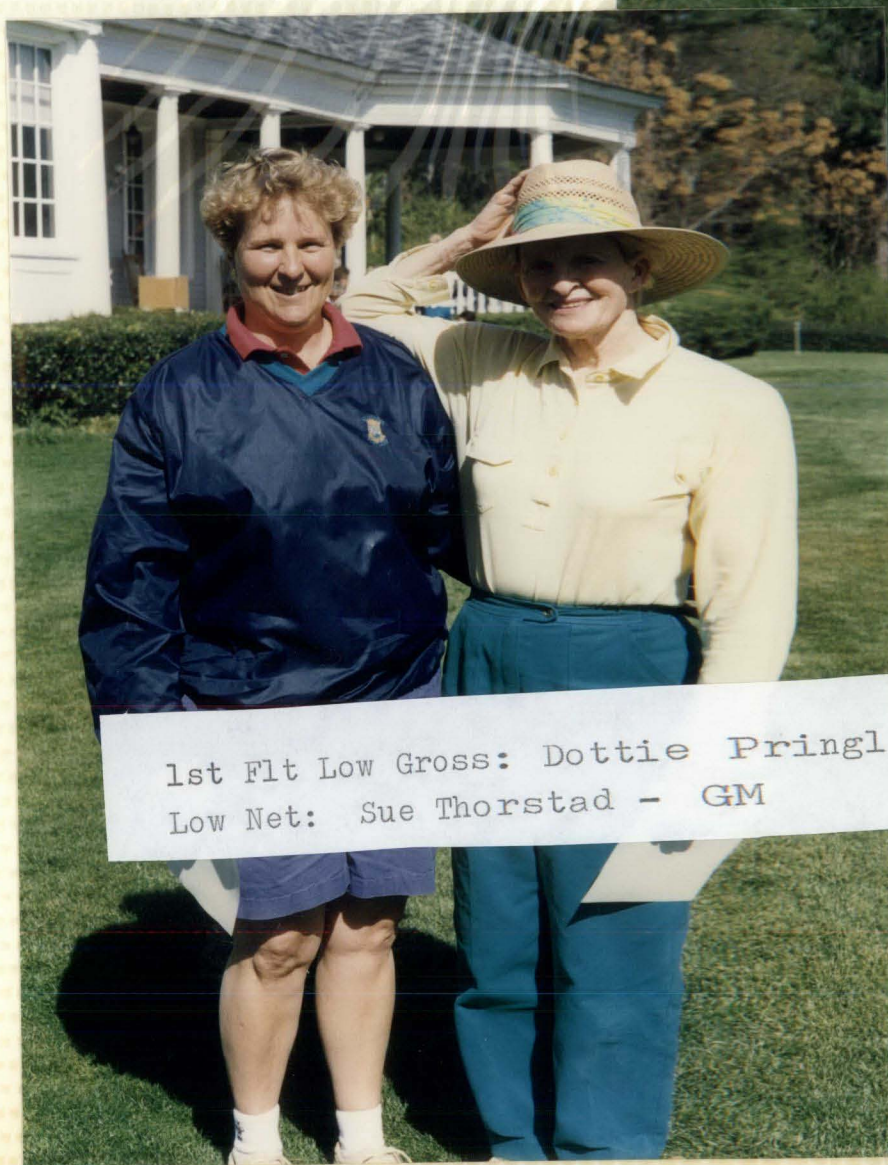

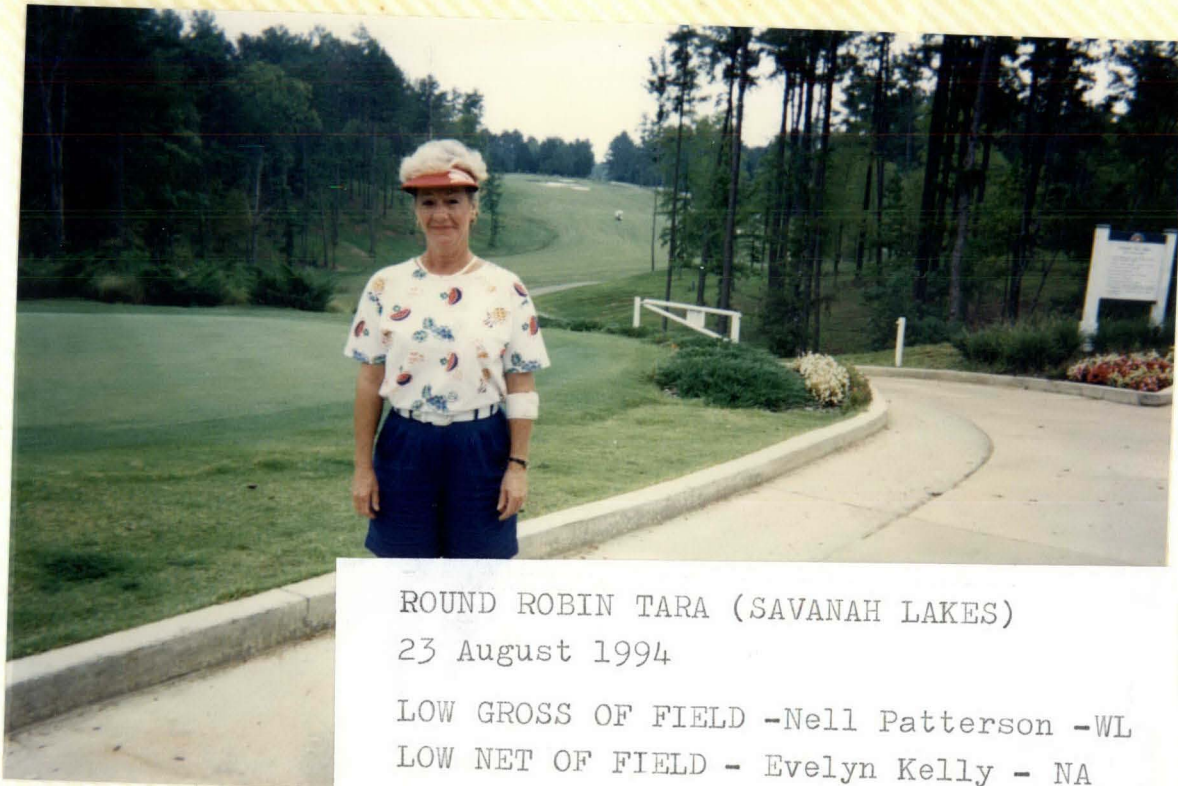
