Next week's LPGA event at Mount Vintage Plantation in Edgefield County, S.C., should not be affected by Tuesday's terrorist attacks, Asahi Ryokuken International tournament director Steve Storm said Wednesday.

"As far as we know, we won't be affected," he said. "By Sunday or Monday, things should be somewhat normal, I hope."

The LPGA tour is playing in Portland, Ore., this week. With air traffic grounded Tuesday and Wednesday because of the attacks on New York City and Washington, Storm said that getting the players to his event is a concern.

"As far as we know, we're proceeding that the tournament will be on schedule," he said.

The 72-hole event begins Sept. 20.

One area tournament has been impacted by the attacks. The Carolinas Golf Association's Mid-Amateur Championship has been reduced from 54 holes to 36. The tournament, scheduled to start at Palmetto Golf Club in Aiken on Friday and run through Sunday, will now be played Saturday and Sunday.

The final round of the CSRA Women's Golf Association 54-Hole Championship will be played today as planned at the Tara course at Savannah Lakes Village in McCormick, S.C. The first two rounds of the tournament were held Monday and Tuesday. Cathy McKie of North Augusta carries a two-shot lead into the final round. McKie is seeking her third straight victory in this tournament.

Part-timer wins three-peat

MCCORMICK, S.C. — If Cathy McKie had more time to devote to her game, just think what kind of golfer she could be.

McKie, a part-time golfer at best, won her third straight CSRA Women's Golf Association 54-hole Championship, at Savannah Lakes Village's Tara Golf Course on Thursday.

With a closing 10-over-par 82 at her home course, the North Augustan finished the season-concluding tournament at 250, six shots clear of Green Meadows Country Club's Sue Thorstad.

In the tournament, which followed a rotating-course format, the 46-year-old McKie opened with 84s at Pine Ridge Country Club and Gordon Lakes Golf Course. Thorstad had 82-89 in the first two rounds, which were played Monday and Tuesday.

Between traveling with husband, George, and his Atlanta-based senior softball team; helping daughter Kimberly get ready for college this fall; and running a fish business, McKie had not played or practiced golf for 12 days before this tournament started.

That came in the association's last round robin, at Green Meadows Country Club. Although Tara is her home course, McKie hadn't played it in six months before Thursday.

"There's not much time for golf, so I didn't know how I'd do this week," McKie said. "It's frustrating not being able to find the time to play. I would like to go take some lessons one day. I've never really had any lessons. I've pretty much watched the LPGA Tour golfers and tried to emulate what they do, though that doesn't always work. I wish as a kid I had started early. I didn't start playing until I was 26 years old."

McKie trailed Thorstad by two shots after Round 1 and then led Jill Thompkins of West Lake Country Club by two shots and Thorstad by three going into the final round.

"I was very nervous this morn-

ing," McKie said. "I wanted to shoot 80. I thought that would be a winning score with the way the gals were playing. They weren't going to give it to me. I didn't shoot 80, but I was pretty close."

McKie's lead was cut to one shot after the front nine when she shot 41 and Thompkins had 40. Thorstad shot 42 on the front and trailed by four shots.

McKie came home with a 41 on the back nine, Thorstad had 43 for her 85 and Thompkins 47 for an 87.

"After the 17th hole, I felt much better," McKie said. "I knew unless I put five balls in the water on No. 18 that I'd win it."

The victory moved McKie into a tie for fifth place on the all-time victory list in this tournament, now in its 39th year.

Betty Wren won it five times; and Walton Horton, Kitty Bartley and Sandra Moody are four-time champions. McKie joined Eileen Kask and Jan Cross as three-time winners.
