

McElreath set to defend CSRA WGA title

If there is such thing as a local favorite in the CSRA Women's Golf Association tournament, it would have to be Mary Helen McElreath.

McElreath of Gordon Lakes Golf Course will defend her title at the upcoming 54-hole CSRA WGA Tournament next week. This annual tournament is now in its 46th year and will be played on three different courses over four days.

"We always play three different courses, which makes it a very challenging event," said Carole Pincavage, CSRA WGA Publicity Chairman. "It's a tradition. They have always done it this way. It allows us to rotate among the courses."

South Carolina and Georgia. The round robins, team play, lady/pro tournament and season-ending 54-hole tournament give women opportunities for amateur competitive golf as they rotate events among the member clubs.

"We have all the premier clubs in the area," Pincavage said.

The tournament will start at the Midland Valley Country Club on Monday It will move to Gordon Lakes Golf Course on Tuesday and finish at Houndslake Country Club on Oct. 2. A total of 70 contestants have committed to participate in this event.

Last year, McElreath was the overall winner with a three day score of 229. Lawrette McCann, the runner-up, will not be competing in this year's tournament. Four former champions, Cathy McKie, Jan Cross, Elaine Montano and Sandra Moody, will be competing again. In the first flight, nine ladies have handicap indexes of 9.2 or better, with McElreath, McKie and Montano all being in the first flight. There are eight flights in this year's tournament.

Defending champ recovers from bad hole to keep title

AIKEN - Mary Helen McElreath was forced to go away from her "one shot at a time" game plan in Thursday's final round of the CSRA Women's Golf Association 54-Hole

That happens when you're taking 10 on vour 11th hole.

"It got a little difficult between 11 and 12" to concentrate on her next shots, she said.

'My hair was standing up pretty good for a couple of holes," said McElreath, who bogeyed Nos. 12 and 13, but recovered to play her final five holes in 1-under.

It brought her home in 81 - the day's low round - at Houndslake Country Club. She won by nine shots over fellow Augustan Debra Hatcher, who shot 81-82-82.

McElreath entered with a five-shot lead after rounds of 76 on Monday at Midland Valley Country Club and 79 on Tuesday at Gordon Lakes Golf Course, her home course.

It was McElreath's second consecutive victory in the association's season-ending event.

'I'm very honored to get to hold onto that trophy for another year," said the 54-year-old McElreath, who was the runner-up in her debut in this tournament in 2006.

The talk of the day was McElreath's 10 on No. 2 on the Dogwood nine, which was her 11th of the day. She seven-putted the sloping green, but didn't mind talking about it afterward.

"You've got to laugh, don't you?" she

On the 11th hole, McElreath missed the par-4 green on her second shot, then chipped on, leaving her a 19-footer for par. With the pin cut in the middle of the undulating green. her first putt came within 6 inches of the hole, then rolled back 10 feet. It later rolled back to

where she had started.

After her fourth putt, McElreath doublechecked with her playing partners to see how many shots she'd taken.

Her partners - Hatcher and Cathy McKie -two-putted the hole for bogey.

"Fair or unfair, it took me seven putts to get in," McElreath said when questioned about the pin position.

Going to the 12th tee, McElreath tried to put the disaster behind her.

"I told myself, 'It's over with.' It's just like starting over. It's the great thing about golf. You get to start over 18 times."

McElreath has been able to concentrate more on golf since retiring two years ago from teaching after 26 years at Glenn Hills.

"This gives me a lot of satisfaction," she said of winning back-to-back titles. "There are some great golfers in this association."

One of them didn't make it to the final round. Elaine Montano, a four-time champion who was six shots off the lead, withdrew after Tuesday's second round.

To play in the 54-Hole Championship, a player must have posted at least 20 rounds at her home course over the past nine months. Montano didn't meet that requirement at her course, Green Meadows Country Club.

McElreath defends title as CSRA women's champion

After three challenging but enjoyable rounds of golf, Mary Helen McElreath repeated as CSRA Women's Golf Association champion.

McElreath shot a 54-hole total 236 over three different golf courses. The champion-ship started at Midland Valley Country Club on Monday. It then moved to Gordon Lakes Golf Course on Tuesday and finished at Houndslake Country Club on Thursday.

The tournament capped the 2007-08 season for the CSRA Women's Golf Association. The organization, which was started in 1961, is composed of 15 golf clubs and 440 members from both South Carolina and Georgia. The round robins, team play, lady/pro tournament and season-ending 54-hole tournament give women opportunities for amateur competitive golf as they rotate events among the member clubs.

McElreath was a medalist in each round, shooting a 76 at Midland Valley, a 79 at Gordon Lakes, her home course, and an 81 at Houndslake.

But winning the championship didn't come without some worry for McElreath. Despite winning by nine strokes, McElreath had her worst round at

Houndslake and shot a low round 81, only a stroke off second-place finisher Debra Hatcher's 82.

The biggest concern for McElreath came on the 11th

hole at Houndslake, where she shot a 10, including seven-putting on the par-five 454-yard hole.



A total of 70 contestants committed to participate in this event, including several past champions. McElreath said she was honored to be able to repeat
